



Futsal Competition Code of Conduct

Purpose: The purpose of this code is to ensure that all individuals participating in and attending our Futsal competitions understand and adhere to the standards of behavior that promote a safe, inclusive, and positive environment for everyone involved.

Scope: This Code of Conduct applies to all players, parents, guardians, spectators, officials, and organizers involved in any activity related to the Futsal competition.

1. Players' Code of Conduct:

a. Respect:

- Ensure your child is on time for practices and matches.

- Respect all facilities and property used during competitions and practices.
- Inform the team coach/manager of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of your child or others.

d. Communication:

- Address any concerns or complaints in a constructive manner following proper channels, avoiding confrontation during or immediately after a game.

- Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct may result in warnings, suspensions, or permanent expulsion from the competition.
 - Officials and organizers reserve the right to ask anyone breaching this code to leave the venue.
