

Futsal Competition Code of Conduct

Purpose: The purpose of this code is to ensure that all individuals participating in and attending our Futsal competitions understand and adhere to the standards of behavior that promote a safe, inclusive, and positive environment for everyone involved.

Scope: This Code of Conduct applies to all players, parents, guardians, spectators, officials, and organisers involved in any activity related to the Futsal competition.

- 1. Players' Code of Conduct:
- a. Respect:
  - Always respect opponents, officials, coaches, and teammates.
  - Accept decisions of officials without dispute.
  - Recognise and applaud good plays whether made by your team or the opponent.
- b. Play Fair:
  - Always play within the rules of the game.
  - Avoid any form of cheating or unsportsmanlike conduct.
  - Do not use deliberate tactics that could harm others.
- c. Self-control:
  - Manage emotions and refrain from using foul or abusive language.
  - Never retaliate or engage in aggressive behavior, even if provoked.
- d. Teamwork:
  - Work collaboratively with teammates and coaches.
  - Support and encourage teammates, both during games and practices.
- 2. Parents' and Guardians' Code of Conduct:
- a. Positive Encouragement:
  - Cheer in a positive manner and encourage fair play.
  - Respect decisions made by officials and encourage players to do the same.
  - Avoid shouting, ridiculing, or criticizing players, coaches, or officials.
- b. Role Modeling:
  - Demonstrate appropriate behavior and sportsmanship at all times.
  - Avoid the use of abusive language or gestures.
  - Never engage in or condone unsportsmanlike behavior.
- c. Safety and Respect:

• Ensure your child is on time for practices and matches.

• Respect all facilities and property used during competitions and practices. • Inform the team coach/manager of any physical disability or ailment that may affect the safety of your child or others.

d. Communication:

- Address any concerns or complaints in a constructive manner following proper channels, avoiding confrontation during or immediately after a game.
- 3. Enforcement:
  - Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct may result in warnings, suspensions, or permanent expulsion from the competition.
  - Officials and organisers reserve the right to ask anyone breaching this code to leave the venue.
- 4. Agreement:

By participating in or attending the Futsal competition, all players, parents, and guardians acknowledge that they have read, understood, and agreed to abide by this Code of Conduct.
